Lean Manufacturing Operative - Level 2

Lean Manufacturing Operative will provide individuals with the knowledge, skills and behaviours to enable them to carry out manufacturing activities on multiple products with different specifications consecutively. The qualifications is suitable for new or existing employees of businesses within the sector range from small family run manufacturing operations to large multi-national companies driving countries growth and wealth.

Roles and responsibilities include:

- Prepare, control, contribute to and complete manufacturing operations.
- Follow manufacturing processes and standard operating procedures.
- Maintain health and safety requirements and an organised work area e.g. 5s.
- Develop and support improvement in the manufacturing operation.
- Carry out quality checks throughout the manufacturing operations.
- Work closely with stakeholders and have clear reporting lines to ensure appropriate escalation.

Qualifications

There are no pre-requisite entry requirements for this programme. Either before or during the apprenticeship, apprentices will be required to achieve level 1 qualifications in English and Mathematics prior to taking the end point assessment.

Course Delivery

Delivery will be via a combination of workplace assessment, classroom delivery and self-study for 12 months. Learners will be working towards the apprenticeship standard, with the end-point assessment completed in the final twelve weeks.

In addition to the core knowledge and skills Lean Manufacturing Operatives must complete one of the following job roles options: Production/Assembly, Inspection/Quality assurance, Logistics/Material handling or Production processing/finishing.

- Workplace Organisation.


Core Behaviours

- Respond positively to change in the working environment.


End Point Assessment (EPA)


Level 1 Functional Skills
